STG Aloha Tip: Tracking Weather in Aloha History

Aloha Weather Tracking

In the days before Point of Sale, every Restaurant kept a log book of:

- 1- Nightly specials with number sold
- 2- Staff on the clock
- 3- Weather/Community events of that day.

In your Aloha System, you can track the first two items with no extra work. Since there is no longer a need to keep the log book, weather and community events are not tracked. Here is a tip to start tracking weather and events again and have that information in your history for that day.

Create a Submenu called "Weather & Events". Make new menu items for the information you want to track.

For example, 40-49 Degrees, 50-59 Degrees, Sunny, Raining, Snowing, Snow Storm, Taste of (your city), Parade, Bike Rally, etc...

Make a Category for these events. Put these menu items on the submenu and attach the submenu to the menu the manager uses. Everyday you will need to require your managers to enter the weather and events for the day. When you look up your PMIX Report, include the weather category and you'll have the events forever in your Aloha history.
